






Tools Required: 5/16" Drill • 1/2" Hex Socket • 1/2" Wrench • 5/16" Nut Driver • 3/8" Nut Driver

- 1. Prior to painting, fit your GlaSteps to the body. A good fit is accomplished when mating surfaces fit with minimum light gaps. Note: Vehicle bodies have variations and a perfect fit may not be possible.
- 2. Painting your GlaSteps. To insure a proper paint finish, use a top quality auto paint system and follow the manufacturers instructions. Your GlaStep should be sanded and primed before painting.
- 3. Measure from front mud flap to two bracket hole locations at 15"-18" and 41"-48". Mark these bracket locations. Note: Steel plates have been inserted under fiberglass to mount brackets securely using self-drilling screws.







4. Mount brackets to body with 5/16" bolt and nuts, through existing holes in vehicle at marked locations. Use clip nuts in top holes. Do not tighten nuts.




5. Attach 3124F step supports to FL11 using 5/16" washer head bolts and nuts.




6. Apply foam tape strips to top GlaStep edge.



7. Position GlaStep to body and secure with three #12 x 1-1/4" screws with rubber washers per side.



8. Secure bracket to GlaStep with two #14 x 3/4" self-drilling screws per bracket. Tighten all bolts to 18 foot pounds.



 Place step pad on GlaStep. Peel off tape backing to secure. Don't forget the Owens label! IN-120 7/1/02
