
- 1. Prior to painting, fit your GlaSteps to the body. A good fit is accomplished when mating surfaces fit with minimum light gaps. Note: Vehicle bodies have variations and a perfect fit may not be possible.
- 2. Painting your GlaSteps. To insure a proper paint finish, use a top quality auto paint system and follow the manufacturers instructions. Your GlaStep should be sanded and primed before painting. NOTE: Position cab boards on brackets first. Do not fasten cab board to body. Position box board to brackets, align both, then fasten to body.



















using 5/16" nuts and bolts. Do not tighten at this time.





7. Clean surface prior to attaching tape and step pads with denatured alcohol. Apply foam tape to back of step where it mates with body. Place step pad on GlaStep. Peel off tape backing to secure.



Drill 5/16" 5/16" Bolt 8A. Make sure cab and box boards line up. Always mount cab boards first. Leave front boards loose so adjustments can be made. See

above note. 8B. Position step on bracket aligning step with cab step. Attach to box using #12 x 1-1/4" self-drilling screws with rubber washers at front. Drill 5/16" hole at rear through fiberglass and hole in angle brace. Insert screw with 5/16" nut and bolt.





9. Attach GlaStep to bracket using two #14 x 3/4" self-drilling screws per support. Adjust height of step, then tighten all bolts.
