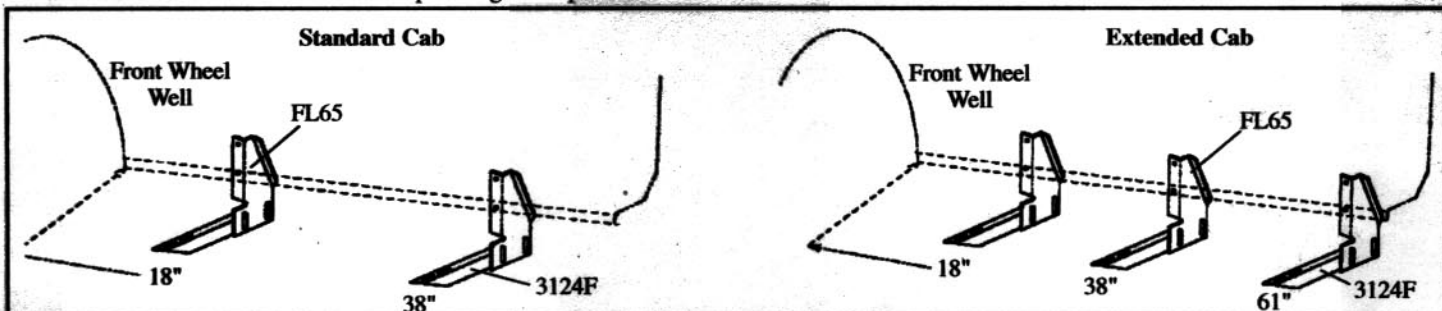

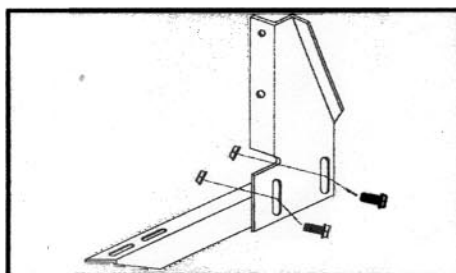

5/16" Drill • 1/2" Hex Socket • 1/2" Wrench • 3/8" Nut Driver

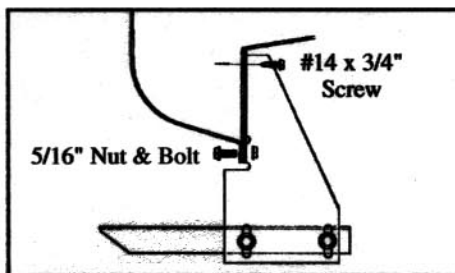
1. Prior to painting, fit your Owens' Premier running boards to the body. A good fit is accomplished when mating surfaces fit with minimum light gaps. Note: Vehicle bodies have variations and a perfect fit may not be possible.
2. Painting your Owens' Premier running boards. To insure a proper paint finish, use a top quality auto paint system and follow the manufacturers instructions for painting ABS plastic.



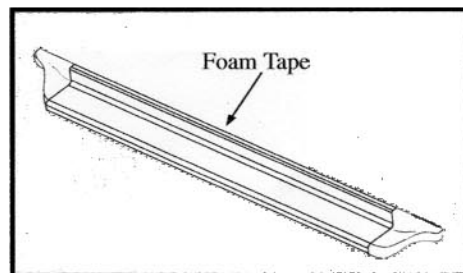
3. Measure from front wheel well, back to dimensions shown above. Mark these bracket location centers.



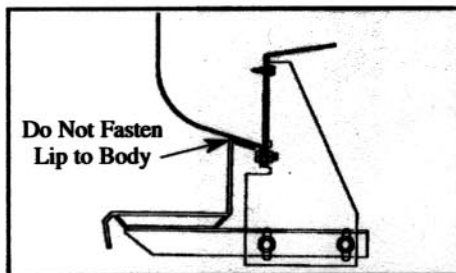
4. Assemble FL65 to 3124F using two 5/16" nuts and bolts. Do not tighten at this time.



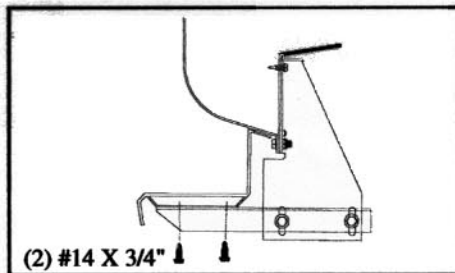
5. Drill 5/16" diameter hole through pinch weld at marks. Bolt FL65 flat bracket to pinch weld seam with 5/16" x 3/4" bolt and nut, then use #14 x 3/4" self-drilling screw in top hole into rocker panel.



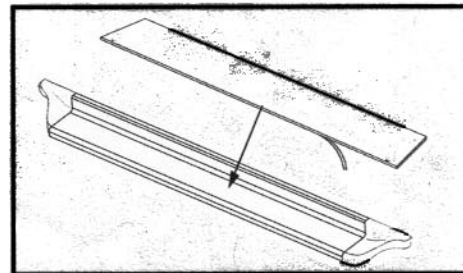
6. Apply foam tape strips to step edge.



7. Note: Do not screw lip to body.



8. Secure step support bracket to bottom of board using two #14 x 3/4" self-drilling screws per bracket. Tighten all bolts to 18 foot pounds.



9. Place step pad on step. Peel off tape backing to secure. Don't forget the Owens label!

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
