




- Prior to painting, fit your Owens' Premier running boards to the body. A good fit is accomplished when mating surfaces fit with minimum light gaps. Note: Vehicle bodies have variations and a perfect fit may not be possible.
- Painting your Owens' Premier running boards. To insure a proper paint finish, use a top quality auto paint system and follow the manufacturers instructions for painting ABS plastic.




3. Measure from front wheel well, back to dimensions shown above. Mark these bracket location centers.



Assemble BT07 to FL20 using three 5/16" nuts and bolts. Do not tighten at this time.




s. Place bracket assembly into position on marks as shown. Use two #14 x 3/4" self-drilling screws to secure to body. Drill 9/32" diameter hole (see drawing) through pinch weld then into FL20 bracket. Use 1/4" carriage bolt with 1/4"



Note: Do not screw lip to body. Place board onto brackets and position. Secure step support bracket to bottom of board using two #14 x 3/4" self-drilling screws per bracket. Tighten all bolts to 18 foot pounds.

7. Attach 3124F step support to FL20 using 5/16" nuts and bolts. Do not tighten at this time.
