


TOOLS REQUIRED: 5/16" DRILL \* 1/2" HEX SOCKET \* 1/2" WRENCH \* 5/16" NUT DRIVER \* 3/8" NUT DRIVER

SOME DRILLING INTO THE BODY IS REQUIRED


- Prior to painting, fit your GlaSteps to he body. A good fit is accomplished when mating surfaces fit with minimun light gaps. Note: Vehicle bodies have variations and a perfect fit may not be possible.
- Painting your GlaSteps. To insure a proper paint finish, use a top quality auto paint system and follow the manufacturers instructions. Your GlaSteps should be sanded and primed before painting.




Measure from the wheel well, back to the dimensions shown above. Mark these bracket location centers. Note: Steel plates have been inserted under fiberglass to mount brackets. Double check your marks to be sure they line up with the steel plates before drilling. Also there are many holes, USE THE RIGHT ONES!



Clean surface prior to attaching tape and step pads with denatured alcohol. Apply foam tape to top lip of board. Position step pad on stepping surface. Peel off tape backing starting with the rear strip. keep pad in position, peel off backing then apply pressure to top of pad to stick tape to board. Continue above steps for all tape strips.




- Insert a blindnut into the factory holes at the locations shown above. Attach a ASO1 bent tab at each rivnut location, now attach a FL94 to the bent tabs. Drill a 5/16" hole through the pinch weld at each flat bracket location, lined up with the hole in the bracket.
- Make sure your GloSeps are level, tighten all bolts to 18 foot pounds. Do not overtighten the sheet metal screws, he sheet metal is thin. Do not overtighten.




6. Position step on brackets and tight to truck body. Screw step to truck with #12 x 1-1/4" self-drilling screws with rubber washers (LONG), three per side. Secure step support bracket to bottom of GlaStep) using two #14 x 3/4" self-drilling screws (SHORT) per bracket. Repeat for all Brackets. DO NOT USE LONG SELF TAPPERS UNDER THE BOARD!


